PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

I hope you all had a wonderful and rested break. This week we have the cross country being run on Friday, after it was postponed due to rain in Term 1. It is always a great day to see parents, carers and community members joining us in the morning from 9am to cheer on MacTaggart and Sheridan. Hopefully the rain holds off while we run!

Due to circumstances out of their control, we have unfortunately had to postpone the ThinkUknow parent program that was to be delivered by police educators. This will be run later in the year.

I would like to welcome our newest staff members; Mrs O'Donovan who is joining us part-time in the administration office in Term 2, and Mrs Day who was selected through a recruitment process to take on the part-time Agricultural Assistant position for Terms 2-4.

I was so proud to see that we maintained 92% attendance in Term 1. Congratulations to parents and carers for the huge role that they play in this. As a parent, I am very aware of the difficulties that we can face trying to get children to come to school and nurture them when they are sick. I will be emailing families to let them know if their child's attendance in Term 1 was concerning or slipping, and welcome parents/carers to talk to teachers or myself about ways we can work together to improve attendance. As we know, a child's attendance directly relates to their chances of being successful. A day here and there can quickly add up, and in fact, just one day off per fortnight is equal to missing 1.5 years of schooling over their school life!

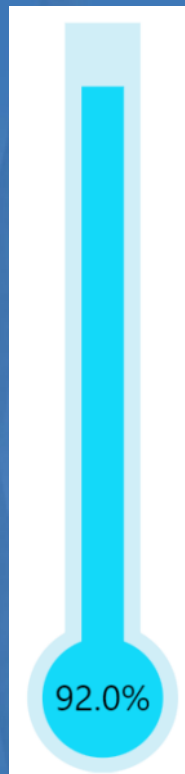

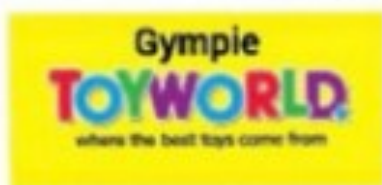
