The 5-6 class have been very busy this term!



In English, the Year 5 class has read *The Lorax* and watched the film, then practiced writing a comparison of the two. This week, we are beginning to read *Babe: The Sheep-Pig* to prepare for our assessment later in the term. The Year 6 class has been reading and comparing informative and narrative texts on the same topic. Many were very sad to read about the mistreatment of Moon Bears, and we all agreed that the picture book *Moon Bear Rescue* was much more powerful than the information brochure about bear farms.

We have just wrapped up our unit on time and are reviewing fractions and decimals in Maths. Students have been loving our Maths rotations, where students complete hands-on tasks, play games, use computers and work in small groups with staff to allow for repetition, multiple exposures and different applications of the content.

Students have also been busily creating a special gift for Mother's Day, where they have designed their own images using computer software. We hope that all of our loving parents and carers enjoy their special day this weekend!
